Community Connections is a **FREE** support service offered by the Door County Partnership for Children and Families. This service is voluntary, strengths based, family driven and culturally sensitive in nature.

Service facilitation is done by a **Community Connector**. This connector is a parent peer who has experienced challenges themselves, has received Door County services, and knows how to advocate for their family.
