Introductions/Agency Updates:

- Cori shared that a new CCS Case Manager (Hope Klatt) started on Monday in Human Services. A new Business Manager for Human Services also started recently.
- Congratulations to Milly! Milly received the Anne Kok Social Justice Award at the Help Annual Community Meeting.
- Milly shared that there is a documentary on Netflix (and other places), *The Mask You Live In*, that would be good to watch. The film looks at the current cultural definition of masculinity, its impact, and what we can do about it.

Executive Committee Updates:

- The Partnership's Annual Celebration Meeting was held on Friday, June 8th. This event had approximately 30 people in attendance and went very well. As part of the meeting, a World Café conversation was held. There was great discussion during the World Café. The Executive Committee will review the suggestions and comments made at their August meeting. The information will also be presented at the September Quarterly Partnership meeting and will also be used in developing the next strategic plan.
- The current Raising a Thinking Child class started on Thursday June 14th and will continue until July 26th.

Events and Trainings

- 7 Essential Ingredients of Trauma Informed Care
 - This training will be held on Wednesday, July 11th from 8:30 – 4:30 in the Sanctuary at Prince of Peace Church in Sturgeon Bay.
 - This training is open to all members of the Partnership. It is not open to the general public, due to the training contract with SaintA's.
 - As of this meeting, there were 10 people registered to attend the training.
 - Candis is working on lunch for the event.

 - We all (whole community) have an obligation to make change and support our children and families.
 - Need to continue to look at who should be involved and at the table.
 - This will be the focus of our next meeting (Friday, July 20th from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m.)
 - We will review the evaluations and comments from the showings.
 - We may also show the shorter episodes during Quarterly Partnership meetings.
- Sexual Assault Center Training
 - It was discussed that we are currently planning for several trainings and opportunities. At this time, we will wait to plan a training with the Sexual Assault Center.
 - It was suggested that we partner with the CCR group (Coordinated Community Response), since their focus is domestic violence and sexual assault.
 - We will continue to look at this for next year.
