 - A showing of the film was done on Wednesday, May 16th at the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Door County. There were 10 people in attendance. While the group was small, there was great discussion.

 - UW-Extension has purchased the rights to the film for another year.

 - Katie suggested that the Mental Health Focus Group would be interested in partnering on this training as well.
 - It was suggested that perhaps part of the training could focus on information on mail-order brides.
 - It was suggested that we talk to Help of Door County to see if they would be willing to partner as well.
