**Introductions/Agency Updates:**

- DC Dept. of Human Services: Cori shared that Human Services is now currently fully staffed.
- Family Services: Gina shared that they have hired two new staff members and are facilitating a summer teen program for 14 years and up – the program builds on team skills and life skills
- United Way: Amy shared this year’s annual fundraising event will be “Second Chance Prom” to be held at Mr. G’s on Saturday, September 29, 2018 cost is \$55/person or \$100/couple. Price includes a plated meal, silent auction, and entertainment by the Love Monkeys
- UW-Extension and DCPCF: Tenley shared they will be having a mini-block party at the fair on August 2<sup>nd</sup> and August 3<sup>rd</sup> and at the ADRC on September 27, 2018
- UW-Extension and DCPCF: Tenley reported the current session of Raising a Thinking Child is still going very well and wraps up on Thursday, July 26<sup>th</sup>
- HELP of Door County: Milly reported HELP has remained busy and mentioned an upcoming Women’s March taking place in Milwaukee
- DCPCF: Community Connections – Rebecca continues supporting families and successfully helped Sevastopol start a Special Education Parent Advisory Council
- DCPCF: Parent Cafés – plans are being made to host a 3-session, bi-weekly, parent café around the protective factors this fall
- Door-Tran has their 4th annual Fun Event coming up on August 19, 2018 at Egg Harbor Fun Park ---- \$20 for unlimited go-karts and mini-golf from 2pm to 5pm

**Executive Committee Updates:**

- The Executive Committee will be reviewing the items that came up in the World Café discussion at the Annual Celebration. We will have further discussion on these items during the September Quarterly Partnership meeting which is being held on Friday, **September 14, 2018 at 8:15am** in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Multi-Purpose Room at the Justice Center.
- The Door County Partnership for Children and Families and the United Way of Door County will be bringing the Dolly Parton Imagination Library to Door County at the beginning of 2019.       - ii. We are looking at possibly hosting a series of films/discussions in October – December. Candis will be meeting with the Mental Health Focus Group event subcommittee to discuss this further
    2. Raising of America
      1. Tenley compiled feedback from the group to create a logic model
        - i. Next Steps:
          - a) Get employers in the conversations and at the table – on the Executive Committee for the Partnership
          - b) Look to Green Bay and their PIE (Parents, Industries and Educators) for direction/ideas
          - c) Get additional ideas from: Wisconsin Early Childhood Association (WECA), Door County Economic Development Corporation (DCEDC), Hatco, Childcare Resource & Referral, Other counties/agencies who have performed this work, Political Representatives
        - ii. Current Logic Model Outputs based on Group Feedback
          - a) Educational Opportunities (ALICE, brain development, SEL and workforce development, childcare opportunities, etc)
          - b) Additional Film Screenings (shorter and longer versions)
          - c) Host Summit for the business community
          - d) Survey to capture personal stories from families struggling
          - e) 1-on-1 Engagement with potential childcare providers, including education for community providers
