Introductions/Agency Updates:

- Door-Tran: Fun event went well and was a success.
- Help of Door County: Death's Door BBQ fundraiser will benefit Help of Door County.
- Family Services:
 - Green and Gold Gala is coming up on September 7th. This is a night of dancing, live auction, and silent auction. Cost is \$250 per ticket. Door County programs do benefit from this fundraiser.
 - If anyone has referrals for the Healthy Families program, please send those to Gina.
- Public Health:
 - The Prevent Suicide Walk will be Monday, September 10th at 5:30 in Martin Park. T-shirts will be available for \$5.
 - Prevent Suicide Book Talk – September 27th, 12:00 – 1:30 at Door County Library in Sturgeon Bay. The book is *Bear Town* by Frederik Backman.
- STRIDE: School Based Mental Health Programming will be starting in the 4 mainland school districts on October 1st. At this time, all of the school boards are in agreeance and the agencies/schools have been partnered.
 - These will be like satellite offices for the providers. The goal is to remove barriers for students who are not currently able to receive mental health services.

Executive Committee Updates:

- We are currently in the process of looking for a 3rd staff member for the Door County Partnership for Children and Families. This person will be a Family Engagement Leader, and will be responsible for planning, coordinating, and implementing various events and programs for families – including Block Parties, Parent Cafés, assisting with Raising a Thinking Child, and more.
- The Executive Committee has been discussing the items that came up during the World Café Conversation during the Annual Celebration. We will continue to look at these suggestions at the Quarterly Partnership meeting in September.

- Event/Panel
 - Youth: What were some of the barriers? What are some of the positive things that helped you?
 - Talk about parents who have ACEs – how can this impact their parenting styles and children?
 - Have people available to talk if needed
 - Do ACEs questionnaire
 - Panel members should spend a few minutes talking about their experiences, then answer questions
 - It was suggested that we ask Panel Members if they would be comfortable sharing their ACEs score (either all share or none share)

- Could put ACEs score on nametag if they all decide to share.
 - Have a meeting with panel members a few weeks in advance.
 - Event Flyer: Candis is working with the Mental Health Focus Group to create a flyer that can be used. Flyer will advertise for all upcoming screenings.
- Raising of America
 - We need to continue thinking about what we will be doing to continue the conversation.
 - At the July meeting, the committee developed a logic model, but did not set specific next steps.
 - We are accomplishing some of the items identified on the logic model with the films/panel discussions and activities being put on by the Family Enrichment Committee.
 - We need to figure out how to get the business community involved.
