**Introductions/Agency Updates:**

- AOD Coalition: The County will possibly have a cannabis referendum in the Spring. This will be discussed at the next AOD Coalition meeting (Tuesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>). The AOD Coalition is looking at planning community conversations.
- STRIDE: Providing Mental Health Services in the Schools; Starting at the beginning of October in Gibraltar; other schools should start soon.

**Executive Committee Updates:**

- We are currently in the process of looking for a 3<sup>rd</sup> staff member for the Door County Partnership for Children and Families. This person will be a Family Engagement Leader, and will be responsible for planning, coordinating, and implementing various events and programs for families – including Block Parties, Parent Cafés, assisting with Raising a Thinking Child, and more.
- The Executive Committee will be doing strategic planning for the next few years. Information provided at the Annual Celebration and the September Quarterly Partnership meeting will be used to create the strategic plan.
- Dolly Parton's Imagination Library: The Door County Partnership for Children and Families will be bringing the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library program to Door County. This is a free book gifting program for Door County children. To qualify for the program, children must live in Door County and be under the age of 5. This program is FREE for families – there is no cost to register. The cost of the program (\$25 per child per year) is covered by the DCPCF and community donations.

  - We should discuss this possibility with schools and then create a planning committee.
