

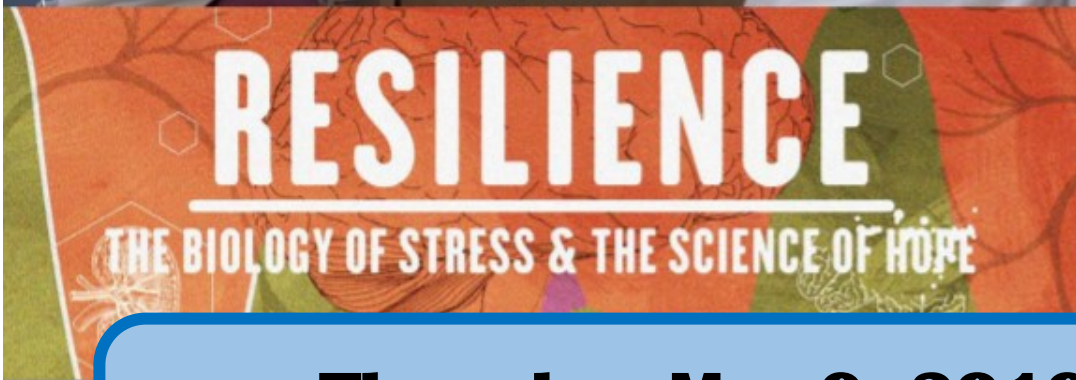
# A Film Screening and Panel Discussion on Toxic Stress and the Science of Resilience
