 - Sturgeon Bay was well attended and had good conversation.
 - Washington Island was also well attended. The attendees expressed the desire for future Parent Cafes.

Family Well-Being Survey

- The survey was launched at the end of March/beginning of April and was closed at the end of May. Tenley shared the results with the committee.
- There were 375 surveys filled out.
- For future surveys: Need to connect better with St. Peters and Zion Schools.
 - Possible future question rewording – Question 16: If you decided you were interested in an event, how frequently would you attend?
- In looking at it quickly, it shows that Parental Stress is one of the biggest challenges.
- The committee will dig into these results deeper at our next meeting on June 24th.
 - After that meeting, we will discuss our next steps (what to do with this data, who else should we invite to come and discuss this with, etc.)
