  - a. Dolly Parton Imagination Library = 691 active children, 319 graduates – we are at 100% market coverage per Dolly Parton Foundation
  - b. Raising A Thinking Child = more to come in 2022
  - c. Parent Cafes = more to come in 2022
3. Staff Updates – Rebecca Nicholson
  - a. Community Connections – remains quiet
  - b. Diapers/Wipes/Formula – since the start - 121 requests / 8 referred to longer term supports
  - c. Welcome Baby – application pending with UWDC Annual Campaign. This program screens new mothers either prenatally or at birth, provides a welcome baby packet and a visit by a Family Resource Specialist. Brochure attached with meeting minutes.
  - d. Parents Supporting Parents – Deanna continues to complete her necessary trainings. She is currently completing the Building a Better Future training and is shadowing CPS staff. We are hoping to be ready to take referrals at the beginning of February 2022.
