

## 2024-2026 Strategic Plan – committee formation

### Sub-Committee Descriptions

**Parent Support:** The Door County Partnership for Children and Families Educator offers a wide array of parent education. Additionally, our Community Connector does a great job of connecting parents to formal supports and programs when needed. Still, some parents struggle to apply lessons learned in parenting classes. Others fall through the cracks or don't meet eligibility requirements for formal case management services. This committee will explore these gaps of our current systems and explore options for addressing them with current community resources or development of something new. The committee will present recommendations to the Executive Committee for consideration by June 2025. The committee will oversee implementation of these new parent support initiatives.

**Sustainability & Growth:** This committee will oversee ongoing fund-raising efforts to not only sustain the current level of financial resources, but increase support from grants and private/corporate donations to position the Partnership for future growth to meet the ever-growing needs in the community. It will also develop enhanced marketing and communication strategies to increase visibility of the Partnership's impact in the community in support of our fund-raising goals. The committee will begin meeting in early July and present recommendations to the Executive Committee for consideration by September 30, 2024.

**Community Resources:** This committee will study options for enhancing the reach of the Partnership's services and resources to every part of the county. Preliminary ideas include development of "Family Resource Hubs" (Centers) at schools, library branches, or other locations; expansion of virtual service-delivery; additional educator and connector staff focused on various geographic areas. The committee will work closely with the Sustainability and Growth Committee to present preliminary recommendations to the Executive Committee by November 2024 to support a potential grant application for this purpose.
